NOTICE OF ANNUAL MEETING

It is once again time for the Pal Mar Water Control District's (PMWCD) Annual Landowners' Meeting. The District was created for the purpose of providing a water management system for the Pal Mar area consistent with local planning, zoning and land use plans. The District's governing Board is composed of five Supervisors. Two are appointed by the respective County Commissions (Palm Beach & Martin County) and three members are elected by the landowners in Pal Mar.

The District's Board of Supervisors sets District policies, levies assessments to support the operations and maintenance of the District's facilities, appropriates funds and directs staff activities. We welcome you to attend the Annual Meeting and encourage you to participate in your water control district.

VOTING INSTRUCTIONS

One Supervisor will be elected at the Landowners' Meeting for the seat currently held by Lewis Lolmaugh. To be a Supervisor of the PMWCD, the candidate must own land within the District and be a resident of either Palm Beach or Martin County, Florida.

If you cannot attend the Landowners' Meeting, you may send your proxy with someone who will be attending the meeting. Printed ballots will be available at the meeting to cast votes for a Supervisor. The landowners casting votes must provide proof of ownership of land to the Chairman of the Landowners' Meeting, within a reasonable amount of time, if requested.

SOUTH FLORIDA WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT NON PAYMENT UPDATE

The State of Florida, via the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) and the Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund (TIITF), have not paid the assessments on property they own.

Since the lands are owned by a government, the County cannot foreclose on their property for non payment. The State is the single largest property owner in Pal-Mar, accounting for approximately 70% of the property.

The PMWCD Board is actively considering any and all options for resolution. This issue could result in a major increase in the annual assessment. This topic will be discussed at the Annual Landowners' Meeting.
