Attorney Glen Torcivia stated that Ms. Holmes had reached out to the Palm Beach County Tax Collector's Office to verify if administrative fees had been added to the invoice total and was awaiting a response.

Discussion of Bowman Work Order

Mr. Maehl (Martin County) presented the work order from Bowman for the first phase of surveying services based on discussions from his initial meeting conducted with Mr. Barnes from Bowman on 11/16/25. Commissioner Heard asked questions regarding the project timeframe and costs. Mr. Maehl responded that Bowman would like to start work during the dry season, and the cost of the initial surveying would be \$88,555. Mr. Cutting asked if the easement listed on Exhibit B was a statutory easement and if the responsibility fell on the District. Mr. Maehl responded that he did not believe that it was owned by the District but may be utilized for maintenance. District Engineer Bob Higgins responded that it would be considered a levy easement, and the responsibility would fall on the District.

After board discussion, Commissioner Marino directed District staff to bring back a proposal for consideration at the next scheduled Regular Board Meeting.

1. Boundary Surveys (SC-01)

- 1. Prepare a Boundary Survey, as defined in Chapter 5J17-05 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).
- 2. The surveys are located at two different locations as listed below:
 - The Pal Mar Water Control District fee title property approximated on Exhibit "A" (Included).
 - The Eastern Pal Mar Water Control District Boundary along the East line of Section 12, Township 40 South, Range 40 East.
- 3. Survey markers will be set at a maximum interval of 1000 feet and at all changes of direction.


